Attendance

Our school attendance target is **96%**.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club is available to all pupils in Nursery to Year 6 inclusive.

We are part of the Government's Breakfast Club Scheme where a number of schools provide a free Breakfast Club to all children.

If your child wants to attend Breakfast Club, they will need to be in school by 8.15am to allow them enough time to eat their breakfast and so entry won't be granted after 8.15am.

As we grow the club, we will work on providing further variety within the menu but also at the same time we have to meet School Food Standards.

Whilst we manage staffing and numbers of children attending we will continue with our current booking system to ensure we have the correct staff to pupil ratio (for H&S and safeguarding reasons) so it is vital if you want your child to attend then they are booked in. You can book your child into Breakfast Club using your School Money App - Teachers2Parents.

Considerate Parking

Please do not park on the yellow zigzags in front of the school.

We also ask all families to show respect to our neighbours and not swear at them. Parents/Carers who are disrespectful to school staff and neighbours will not be allowed on school grounds and may be reported to the police.

There has been some delay in children being automatically moved to the new year group and I am very grateful to the office staff for working so hard in moving every child across manually. This should now be completed but please let us know on Monday if you are still unable to access the app.

Nursery and Reception children have made a super start to school this week. The children will be coming in at their usual start times from next week. They are welcome to attend our free breakfast club at 8.15 but must be booked in. A reminder that both classes will be closed next Friday as parents and carers have the opportunity to meet the teachers.
