Attendance

Our school attendance target is **96%**.

Missing just 2 days of school every month means a child's attendance drops to 90% – which is classed as persistent absence. Over a school year, this adds up to missing 4 whole weeks of learning! Every day in school counts, and even small improvements in attendance can make a big difference to your child's progress and wellbeing.
