Tips to keep your child safe online

Talk to your child - Talk to them about what they're doing online and how to stay safe. Let them know they can come to you, or another adult they trust, if they feel worried or upset by anything they've seen online. They can also get support from Childline on 0800 1111.



Explore apps and sites together - Explore what your child likes to do online together. This can help you to understand why they're using certain websites. Explore the features that are available, which would include privacy settings, location settings, and how to block and report.

Agree what's appropriate together - Agree your own rules as a family when using apps, sites or games.
